Parent Contribution Resource Scheme

These funds are used for:

- Playground improvements
- Library resources & subscriptions
- Printed & photocopied learning resources
- Photocopiers, printers & consumables for school communication & learning resources.
- Classroom consumables such as art materials for special occasions like Mothers Day, Fathers Day, Christmas etc.
- Sporting & Music resources/equipment
- Mathematics & Science resources/equipment
- Additional computers, networking & software
- First aid supplies
- Technology repairs and maintenance
- Canteen equipment

Additional Costs may eventuate during the school year for educational excursions, performances, school camps, visiting experts etc.

Parents will receive notification as these might arise.

Parent Contribution Resource Scheme

School Kids Bonus Payment:

Starting from the 1st January 2013, the Commonwealth Government introduced a 'School Kids Bonus' payment to help eligible families.

* NB: Children in preschool are not eligible for the School Kids Bonus.

Hardship

It is possible to pay the parent contribution scheme in installments, such as \$ 25 per child per term.

If you are experiencing financial difficulty and are not eligible for the School Kids Bonus payment mentioned above, please contact the school Principal to discuss other ways you can contribute on a case by case basis.

Public Education

Commonwealth & NT Governments Fund:

- Building repairs & maintenance
- Operational Funding for Essential Services, Cleaning & Grounds
- Capital improvements—major works such as new buildings
- Minor new works—works up to \$300'000 (on a submission / case by case basis)
- Funding for teachers, administration, support, cleaning & grounds maintenance staff.
- Access to services such as guidance officers, special services officers and curriculum officers.
- Base funding for some classroom furniture, computers (1 computer to 10 students), school supplies & resources.

Back to school Payments

The NT Government provides parents with a Back to School Payment of \$150 to help pay for essential school supplies— text books, stationery, uniforms & other essential school items.

Please Note: At Bees Creek your payment can be used to purchase your child's book pack, DIPL text book or uniforms at the start of each year. Government regulations specify that payments **cannot** be redeemed for cash, spent elsewhere, or used to pay parent contribution schemes. They must also be spent by the end of 1st term.
